

Kinloch Castle

Time to walk from pier to Castle: approx 20 minutes

Tours last for 45 minutes

Directions:

When you leave the boat, follow the main track uphill from the pier. The track curves around the bay past the school. At the fork in the road take the right hand track down towards the old harbour, where you may see an otter playing if the tide is high. Pass the visitor centre and public toilets on your left and continue on past the campsite on your right.

At the next junction leave the shore road and take the higher road past some houses. You are now on the original avenue which leads to Kinloch Castle. Cross the bridge over the river and you will be able to see the castle through the trees. Tours start from the front door.

If you have time for a cup of tea or a visit to the Craft Shop after your tour, turn left when you leave the Castle and walk to the crossroads. Go straight on for the Village Hall, or turn right for the Craft Shop.

What to bring:

The west coast is known for its high rainfall, so a raincoat and waterproof footwear are always a good idea – just in case!
